Lesson 3: The 'K' sound

This is the imitation of the snare drum.



It is usually written as a K on beatbox flute scores.

To produce a strong sound:

- Say 'Curve' or Curry' without any voice
- Think high and bright to make the sound sizzle
- Try to keep your throat closed (ng sound, larynx is high)
- You may need to flick your tongue down at first
- Make the air explode from high in your mouth
- Use lots of energy and breath!

The K sound:

- is often used on off beats
- Can be produced on an exhale or an inhale
- Can be used with Aeolian or full tone (but full tone is hard to achieve – remember to really move your mouth!)
